### **Qualifications for Participation in the Car for Work Program (CWP)**

- ◆ Single mom and primary caregiver of a child 12 and under (child lives with mother)
- ◆ Own a vehicle.
- ◆ Live in Montgomery County, Ohio.
- ◆ Work at least 20 hours per week or attend college at least part-time in a degree program.
- ◆ Take the G.E.D. test (if you have not graduated from high school).
- ◆ Have a valid driver's license and own a car.
- ◆ Show proof of auto insurance.
- ◆ Actively seeking a better quality of life for yourself and your children.
- ◆ Meet income qualifications (contact Samaritan Outreach for details).
